### PROGRESS REPORT

5 March 2010

#### KEY ISSUE

To update the Local Committee on the progress of highway schemes and works being progressed in and 2009/10 financial year.

On 03 July 2009, the Local Committee agreed a list of integrated transport schemes funded from the Local Transport Plan and Local Allocation budgets. This report sets out progress on these highway schemes and other maintenance related works funded from other sources in the current financial year.

<b>A25 High Street, Bletchingley.</b> Layout improvements.	2009/10    £20,000 LTP	Drawings prepared and sent to the local County Councillor and Parish Council for comment and decision about way forward. Comments received and meeting held with Bletchingley Parish in December. Plan to design new refuge near speed camera and amend speed limits in Little Common Lane.
<b>Tatsfield village scheme.</b> Improvements for pedestrians and traffic.	2009/10    £40,000.	Funding available for all highway works in current year approved by Estates Management. Common Land legal issues and procedure likely to take more than 6 months to resolve. Scheme can be substantially implemented before new school opens apart from works on common land which will be progressed asap.
<b>Caterham on the Hill area.</b> Improvements at various locations.	2009/10    £20,000.	Some minor works this financial year and investigation of some other sites following meeting with Divisional County Councillor in August.  Traffic calming scheme outside St Josephs school in Whyteleafe Rd being investigated. Likely completion end of Feb. 10. Burntwood Lane/Whyteleafe Road traffic signals -- improvement to pedestrian facilities being progressed and to be implemented before the end of March. Pedestrian phase to be changed so that it comes round more quickly to help school children.  Footpath from Whyteleafe Rd to Essendene Rd -- lighting improvements completed.
<b>Caterham.</b> Shabby to Smart.	2010/11    £45 2009/10    £20,000.	£45,000 SCC contribution towards project is confirmed for 2010/11, which has successfully gained a SEEDA grant. About £18,000 has been spent this financial year on drainage work. A scheme is being developed with TDC and the Caterham S2S project. Likely implementation summer 10.
<b>Wapses Lodge</b> Roundabout improvements	2008/09    £90,000 LTP. 2009/10    None.	Surfacing works completed this financial year following extensive refurbishment last financial year. Additional vegetation clearance over coming months on the footways around the roundabout.

<b>HGV routes in Oxted.</b> HGVs accessing Oxted chalk quarry.	2009/10    None	Considered by Local Committee at meetings on 7 May and 5 September 2008. Speed reducing measures near motorway bridge over Chalkpit Lane completed. SGL chalk quarry proposals for a haul road are awaited. Automatic traffic counter in place and monitoring continuing.
<b>Judges Corner.</b> New roundabout. to replace existing staggered junction.	2009/10    £800,000 LTP	Scheme substantially complete apart from landscaping and stage 3 safety audit. Initial utility company apparatus diversions took longer than planned. Failure of some surfacing materials resulted in some remedial works.
<b>Rook Lane, Chaldon.</b> New footway near St Peter & St Paul School.	2009/10    none	A feasibility study for a proposed footway has been completed. Results have been discussed with the Divisional Member before reporting to the Local Committee.
<b>The Avenue, South Nutfield</b> Footway improvement	2009/10 - £20,000	Works substantially complete. Topsoiling to be carried out.

Review 2 investigation of identified parking sites has commenced. Consultation within each Division ongoing and report approved by LC in October 2009. New restrictions advertised on 11 <sup>th</sup> Feb 2010. A Parking Strategy for Tandridge was agreed in March 2009 by the Local Committee.										
<b>Speed Management</b> Speed limit revisions and targeted routes.	2009/10    £25,000 LA and £10,000 Rev.	<p>There is an ongoing 'targeted routes' initiative in Tandridge. This involves identification, assessment and proposals for top priority roads. It includes liaison with Surrey Police and Tandridge District Council.
