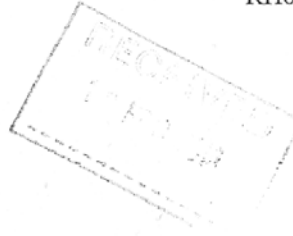

Dear Sirs,

I wish to object to the imposition of 40mph limits on the approach roads to new roundabout at Judges Corner for the following reasons:-

- 1).For many years the 50mph limit has been deemed appropriate on these roads despite the acknowledged dangerous offset crossroads at this point.
- 2).The design of the roundabout with curved approaches is sufficient to slow traffic.
- 3).All other roundabouts in the area do not have variations to limits on their straight approaches.
- 4).If it is still deemed necessary to impose revised limits the distance involved should not need to be greater than 100 yards from the roundabout.

Can I ask why the signs have been and still are being illegally displayed?.

Please note that I use this route at least 2 times per day 6 days a week and occasionally 7 days.
