Dear David Curl,

Further to my phone call to your department on 29th Jan and again last week I confirm my objection to the lowering of the speed limit at the new Judges Corner/Snow Hill roundabout (the junction of the B2037 and B2028).

The reason for the objection is that there is an existing speed limit of 50mph in that area that was introduced in recent years and that as you have improved the road with this new feature it is not logical to then need to lower the speed limit.

Certainly the new roundabout junction is much safer than the old T junction so there is no need for the traffic to go even slower – particularly so far away from the junction where the new signs are currently placed – if needed for the junction (which they are not) the new signs should be within sight of the junction.

Please do not authorise this speed limit until these objections are satisfied.
