# PROGRESS REPORT 24 SEPTEMBER 2010

#### **KEY ISSUE**

To update the Local Committee on the progress of highway schemes and works being progressed in and 2010/11 financial year.

This report sets out progress on highway schemes and other maintenance related works funded from various sources.
