

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (TANDRIDGE)

HIGHWAYS SCHEMES 2011/12 – END OF YEAR UPDATE 2 MARCH 2012

KEY ISSUE

To inform the Local Committee on the outcome of the 2011/12 Integrated Transport and highways maintenance schemes programmes in Tandridge District.

SUMMARY

At the 4 March 2011 Local Committee, Members agreed a programme of work for highways in Tandridge. This report sets out the outcomes of both the Integrated Transport Schemes programme and the programme of maintenance works.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Committee is asked to note the report for information.

1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In March 2011, Tandridge Local Committee agreed a programme of capital Integrated Transport Schemes (ITS) and revenue Maintenance expenditure for 2011/12 in Tandridge District. The capital budget for ITS schemes was £183,573 and the revenue maintenance budget was £100,000. In addition to this, each County Member was allocated £5,000 Community Pride funding to spend on improvements in their local area. The budgets for the above programmes were devolved to the Local Committee.
- 1.2 In addition, there are capital budgets that are delegated to the Head of Surrey Highways for highways works across the County. These budgets cover major maintenance, surface treatments, footway schemes and flooding and drainage schemes.
- 1.3 Developer contributions and other external sources provide a further area of funding of highway improvement schemes.

2 ANALYSIS

- 2.1 Annex 1 sets out the 2011/12 approved programme of works in Tandridge under the headings described above and provides an update on progress to date.
- 2.2 A number of Integrated Transport Schemes have not been completed in this financial year, either because they were programmed to be design only or as a result of delays following the mobilisation of the new highways contract. It is suggested that these schemes be carried forward onto the ITS programme for 2012/13, which is the subject of a separate report to this meeting of Tandridge Local Committee.
- 2.3 Three Local Structural Repair (LSR) schemes were funded from the ITS budget; Ricketts Hill, Tatsfield and Hurstlands, Hurst Green, both of which have been completed and Brickhouse Lane, Lingfield which is programmed to be carried out by the end of the financial year. In addition, LSR schemes have been carried out at the following locations, funded from the central highways budget.

Coulsdon Road, Caterham Avenue Road, Warlingham North Park Lane, Godstone Vicarage Road, Lingfield Sandhawes Hill, East Grinstead Crowhurst Lane, Lingfield Wolfs Row/Hill, Limpsfield Gibbs Brook Lane, Oxted Waterhouse Lane, Bletchingley Redvers Road, Warlingham 2.4 Table 1 below shows the revenue maintenance allocations for 2011/12, together with progress to date. This budget has been spent in full.

- 2.5 Tandridge Local Committee was allocated £30,000 Community Pride Fund, which equates to £5,000 per County Member, to pay for small highway improvements to benefit the local community. This budget has been spent in full to carry out works such as providing a new grit bin, treeworks, signing and employing a gang for up to 6 weeks to carry out minor works in three divisions.
- 2.6 Two major maintenance schemes were delivered in Tandridge and an extensive programme of surface treatment schemes has been substantially delivered. A number of micro asphalt schemes that could not be completed this year due to weather constraints have been carried forward on to the 2012/13 programme.
- 2.7 A number of externally funded schemes have been delivered this financial year. A mini-roundabout at the junction of Harestone Valley Road/Church Hill/Station Avenue was delivered using Caterham Shabby to Smart funding. The A25 Bletchingley High Street and Dormansland High Street schemes were both part funded by the Parish Councils. The footway scheme in Rook Lane, Chaldon has been delayed and will now be delivered next financial year, part funded by the Parish Council.
- 2.8 Work is on-going to identify options for using s106 deposits in Tandridge.

3 FINANCIAL AND VALUE FOR MONEY IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The key objective with regard to the 2011/12 budgets has been to manage to a neutral position.

4 EQUALITIES AND DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The Highway Service is mindful of its needs within this area and attempts to treat all users of the public highway with equality and understanding.

5 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

5.1 A well managed highway network can reduce fear of crime and allow the Police greater opportunity to enforce speed controls.

6 CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1 This report sets out the highway works carried out in Tandridge in 2011/12, for Members information.
