In recent years the building was used as a church, but it has been closed for sometime and as a result the building is in need of some repair and refurbishment in order to be transformed into a local community centre. This particular funding will be used to refurbish the men's and ladies toilets, including new flooring along with electrical work, which is not included in the quote attached to this document. b) what needs will it address? There is currently no youth and community centre in the Farncombe area. It will provide a focal point for the community to engage with one another as well as access a Varsity of activities and events. c) what geographical area will it cover? Farncombe and Binscombe d) who will benefit?
