<p><b>3. Description of Project:</b></p> <p>a) what will be done? Creation of a 22 metre footpath from the Hambledon Road to the top corner of the churchyard. (This Phase 1 of a 2 phase project. Phase 2 at an estimated cost of £15,000 will create a further footpath to the Brighton Road pedestrian crossing).</p> <p>b) what needs will it address? The path will be wide enough for buggies and wheel chair users, will have safety rails and will take the place of an existing path which has a triple set of steps and is very user unfriendly</p> <p>c) what geographical area will it cover? Busbridge, Holloway area</p> <p>d) who will benefit? The aim is to provide a safe footpath from Busbridge Junior School located on the eastern side of the Brighton Road to Busbridge Infants School located in Hambledon Road via the Church grounds. This will facilitate communication between the schools, help parents who have children at both schools - at least 70 parents, many with buggies navigate the journey by road around the church, twice a day, placing themselves and their children in danger from traffic in the Brighton Road, The Drive and then in Hambledon Road. It will also help those attending the church and the many community groups that use the church and its associated buildings - particularly those who are wheel-chair bound.</p> <p>e) Please confirm that, where expenditure is for maintenance or repair of a non-Surrey County Council building, you envisage that building will remain in use for the foreseeable future.
