1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1.1 At its meeting on 17 June 2011 the Committee agreed to divide its capital ("voluntary organisations") budget equally amongst the members of the Committee. It had already agreed parallel arrangements for the allocation if its revenue budget at its meeting on 18 March 2011. The Committee also resolved at its June meeting to delegate to the Community Partnership Manager and Community Partnership Team Leader (West Surrey) the authority to approve budget applications (and refunds) of up to and including £1000, subject to these being reported to the Committee at the following meeting.
