GODALMING BAND APPLICATION FOR GRANT AID TOWARDS COST OF 75 YEAR CELEBRATIONS OF THE BAND'S FORMATION

Summary of Application

Although records show there to have been a Band in Godalming in Victorian times, 2012 marks the 75th Anniversary of the formation of the Godalming Band as we know it today, and 40 years of the Godalming Youth Band. These two bands comprising 30 adults and 35 children, principally from the Godalming area, operate from the Band Room in Summers Road, Farncombe and in a typical year the two bands:-

- Play at a range of Civic Events (Remembrance Sunday, Civic Services etc.)
- Open and close the summer season of Sunday afternoon concerts on the Godalming Bandstand and play for the annual "Songs of Praise" event as part of that season
- Play at a range of carnivals and fetes throughout Waverley, at a variety of events organised by local organisations, at a number of residential homes for the elderly; and play at the annual switch-on of the Christmas Lights in Godalming.

In maintaining a training band (the Godalming Youth Band) the band supports the development of young musicians by providing instrument loans, individual tuition as well as the all important experience of making music with other people. The Youth Band competes each year at the Godalming Music Festival (and is the current holder of the Jericho Cup for best band in class/age group). To develop their musical skills, Band members are encouraged to take and are prepared for the examinations of the Associated Board of the Royal School of Music.

The band participates actively in Godalming's Town-Twinning and has links with the bands in each of Joigny, France and Mayen, Germany as well as with the band in Herpen in the Netherlands. Over the years successful exchange trips have been made, playing concerts, to all these towns, the most recent being participation alongside the Mayen band (and others) at a band festival in Joigny in 2007.

As stated 2012 is an important anniversary year for the Bands and both have been saving and fundraising in order to celebrate the year. They have a full programme of community activity organised for the year, which as well as the range of events referred to above will include:

- Supporting the Godalming commemorations to mark the centenary of the loss of the Titanic in April
- A key role in the celebrations for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee (particularly poignant since the band was formed to mark the coronation of the Queen's father George VI in 1937) in June
- Supporting the Olympic Torch Relay in July

However, for the band the major celebration is the planned visit of both the French and German twin town bands in July for a weekend of musical activity with open-air concerts at

street venues throughout Godalming town centre, a Sunday afternoon of music on the bandstand and a celebratory concert to be held in the Ben Travers Theatre at Charterhouse School.

As stated the Bands continue to fundraise for the year's events (a quiz evening is to be held on 18 May) but the costs of hosting the event have risen unexpectedly with the late cancellation in February of the accommodation booked at Priorsfield School (the school has the opportunity to undertake building work sooner than planned and cannot now make its accommodation available this summer). Disaster has been averted by arranging alternative, but more expensive, accommodation at Charterhouse School and consequently the Band has to seek additional financial support for its planned celebrations.

Financial support is specifically sought for the community aspects of the twinning weekend; towards the costs of hiring concert venues and towards the costs of accommodating the visiting musicians.

Programme for Anniversary Celebrations.

Friday 13 July –arrival by coach of the Joigny Band (approximately 25 musicians plus supporters) and of the Mayen Band (30 musicians plus supporters). Accommodation at Charterhouse School and evening social gathering.

Saturday 14 July-all Bands play in Godalming throughout the morning, at three venues so that each Band plays at each site. Venues are likely to be at the Peppercot, at Crown Court and at the Council Offices, Bridge Street.

-afternoon, joint rehearsal.

-evening concert by all Bands, individually and together at the Ben Travers Theatre. Admission by ticket, available at the usual ticket outlets.

Sunday 15 July –morning free in Godalming

-afternoon, march by all Bands to the Phillips Bandstand for a free concert of traditional French and German music by the visiting Bands

-evening celebratory barbecue for the bands, probably with music by the Youth Band.
