



Martyrs' Lane Civic Amenity Site

KEY ISSUE:

Surrey Waste Management are considering the form of improvements to be made at the Martyrs' Lane Site.

SUMMARY:

This report presents an opportunity for Officers from Waste Management within the Sustainable Development Directorate to update Members on the decisions of Surrey Waste Management in connection with improvements to the Martyrs' Lane Civic Amenity Site. The final decision on the form of improvements is due to be taken on 14th January, 2005 and, therefore, the information will be given in the form of a short presentation.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS:

That Committee is recommended to receive the presentation and make appropriate comments.

1. Introduction and background

1.1 Members will recall that outline proposals for improvements at the Martyrs' Lane Civic Amenity Site were presented to the Local Committee's meeting in the Community held on 29th September, 2004 in West Byfleet. The proposals included a remodelled site layout together with the provision of new skips and replacement of the existing compactors with an adapted JCB to reduce the space taken up by waste. These outline proposals were subject to approval by the Board of Surrey Waste Management (SWM) who operate the site as part of their contract with the County Council.

1.2 The proposals have been the subject of on-going discussions, including the comments made at the Committee's meeting, and it has taken some while for final proposals to be worked up. It is understood that the Board of SWM will be taking a final decision on 14th January. It is intended that the form of the improvements and, hopefully, the time scale for their implementation will be able to be presented to the Committee at this meeting for information and comment.
