Consultation for Pedestrian Crossing - Redding Way

Dear Resident,

The Transportation Service has been asked to investigate the possibility that a pedestrian crossing be placed on Redding Way for people wishing to walk or cycle to Knaphill Village. My immediate reaction is to suggest that it should be in the vicinity of The Vyne. However it would be wrong to act on this assumption without checking with the people who will use the facility.

The attached questionnaire and plan seek your help in establishing the actual routes used by pedestrians from the former Brookwood Hospital site to Knaphill Village or in the opposite direction. Would you please indicate, with a line on the plan, the most commonly used route you or others in the house take in walking/cycling to or from the village. The questionnaire seeks to quantify the actual number of pedestrians or vehicle users in transit to or from the village and their mode of transport. It is necessarily simplistic but sufficient to establish movement patterns.

Thank you for your help with this survey, which should be returned in the reply paid envelope by Monday 25 September. The results will be reported to the Local Committee of County and Borough Councillors on the 2 November 2006 and they will decide whether and where a crossing should be constructed. The residents of Tudor Way and Hampton Close have been included in this survey although the mapping system used does not show these recently built properties.


