NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING

Neighbourhood Policing is about creating safer neighbourhoods. It's about helping us to identify the issues that matter most in your neighbourhood and working with you and our partners to tackle these issues, to create neighbourhoods that are safe and feel safe.

Across Surrey, communities and our partners have helped us identify what you view as your 'natural neighbourhoods' - your local areas. Surrey Police has now allocated dedicated policing teams to each of your neighbourhoods, made up of a mixture of Neighbourhood Specialist Officers (NSOs) and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs).

Part of the Safer Neighbourhood Team, PCSOs are key to how we engage with our communities. They work closely with the public, provide a reassuring presence, deter crime and make a visible difference to people's lives. PCSOs can focus on the needs of the community and help create safer neighbourhoods.

Each neighbourhood team works towards tackling the problems and issues that exist in their areas. They hold regular Panel Meetings and Surgeries when those who live and work in the area can come along, meet their local officers and voice their concerns. It is the public themselves who define what issues matter most to them and prioritise what gets tackled first.

Officers - Neighbourhood Specialist

Police Constables dedicated to areas or neighbourhoods, supported by their Safer Neighbourhood Team. It is their job to forge close links with the local community and their partners. The NSO's local knowledge helps create safer neighbourhoods through the NSOs - Neighbourhood Specialist Support Officers (PCSOs).

Each neighbourhood team works towards tackling the problems and issues that exist in their areas. They hold regular Panel Meetings and Surgeries when those who live and work in the area can come along, meet their local officers and voice their concerns.
