



Woking Cycling Town – Bid to Cycling England – Annex C

Cycling England (CE) have approached Cycle Woking to ask if the CE Grant funding for Cycle Woking is predicted to be under or over spend this year and if we wish to 'bid' for additional funds

There are two schemes that have 'overspent' this year.

- Basingstoke Canal (Pirbright Bridge to Hermitage Bridge) overspend £37,000 due to additional works on towpath and additional link across Brookwood Country Park
- Basingstoke Canal (Monument Road to Sheerwater Bridge) estimated overspend £62,000 due to additional works such as realignment of the towpath, additional bank protection, and revised links to Sheerwater neighbourhood.

Other completed schemes are on target.

The 'bids' are based on schemes being brought forward within the programme.

- New scheme - A322 Bagshot Road pedestrian / cycle crossing outside petrol filling station to improve connection of the Basingstoke Canal towpath. estimated cost £25,000 (originally in programme 2011/12 but 'bid' made following John Grimshaw visit.
- Scheme brought forward from 2010/11 programme. Basingstoke canal improvement (Sheerwater Bridge to Scotland Bridge) estimated cost £40,000
- Scheme brought forward from 2010/11 programme Basingstoke canal improvement (Scotland Bridge to Wey Navigation) stone base only (Fibredec planned 2010/11) £50,000
- Scheme brought forward from 2010/11 programme Rebrand Network estimated cost £20,000

Cycling England were due to meet DfT last week re all 'bids' from the 18 towns /city.
