Summary

Cabinet at its meeting of 4 February 2014 agreed that the Chief Property Officer in consultation with the Head of Procurement, Cabinet Member for Business Services, Cabinet Member for Schools and Learning, the Leader of the Council and Section 151 Officer, authorise the award of future schools capital construction contracts, above £500k in value, where a competitive tender procedure has been followed through the BuildSurrey portal. It was agreed that this authorisation would be formally minuted and the S151 Officer would retain the paperwork.

There is an approved funding allocation in the Medium Term Financial Plan 2014-2019 to fund the provision of modern teaching facilities at Sunnydown SEN Boys School in accordance with SEN Strategy 2010-2014. This report recommends approval to award a contract for the implementation of the main construction works. The replacement teaching facilities are needed by September 2015. The award of this contract will enable the works to be completed on time.

This record formally confirms that a meeting was held under the above delegated Authorities on 21 October 2014, at which the award of the contract for main construction works at Sunnydown SEN Boys School was approved as recommended in the submitted confidential contract award report.
