Summary

[Planning and environment] Service is responding to [**Aviation 2050: The future of UK aviation - Green Paper Consultation**] White Paper/Green Paper/consultation.

This green paper outlines proposals for a new aviation strategy and sets out the challenges and opportunities for aviation to 2050 and beyond. In general, our response supports the Government's position in relation to aviation growth, particularly the emphasis on the need for such growth to take place in a sustainable way, "with actions to mitigate the environmental impacts." This reflects the ongoing issues of concern to us, expressed in a County Council Resolution agreed at the Full Council meeting held on 16 July 2013. We raise issues relating to the noise, surface access, air pollution and climate change impacts of aviation growth on Surrey residents.
