## Summary

Surrey County Council has a statutory duty to manage asbestos containing materials within its premises. A UKAS registered asbestos consultant is required to assist the council in meeting its obligations under the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 by providing professional advice, carrying out asbestos management surveys and annual re-inspections, responding to emergency call outs, managing licenced contractors involved in asbestos remediation works and carrying out air monitoring and asbestos project management of asbestos works on site.

A call-off contract has been awarded to WYG Environment Planning Transport Ltd using the Crown Commercial Services Project Management & Full Design Team Services Framework Agreement.

## Decision made

It was AGREED that a contract be awarded for Asbestos Consultancy Services to WYG Environment Planning Transport Ltd at the total contract sum of £1,506,660
