Summary

The provision of a Care Within the Home (CwH) service to vulnerable adults in Surrey is a statutory requirement of the Council under the Care Act 2014. CwH services enable and support people to remain independent and living in their own homes for longer and involves a range of social support services for all user groups. CwH includes personal care which involves supporting people with things like washing, bathing or cleaning themselves, getting dressed or going to the toilet.
