## Summary

Surrey County Council are looking for a provider to deliver Care & Support at both Beechwood Court & Chestnut Court, an extra care housing scheme run by A2 Dominion. Such a service is currently, and will in future, be comprised of a dedicated service which delivers a 24/7 emergency care presence alongside a care team to respond to planned support needs amongst SCC-funded residents.

Both Contracts are scheduled to start on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023.
