## Summary

Surrey County Council has been successful in securing a £6.3m grant by DWP to roll out Individual Placement and Support in Primary Care (IPSPC) across Surrey Heartlands and Frimley Integrated Care Systems (ICS).

IPSPC Surrey will ensure Surrey residents with mental or physical health conditions or disabilities, including learning disabilities and neurodivergence, receive the health and wellbeing benefits of accessing and maintaining employment for the longer term.

IPSPC Surrey includes support for each Primary Care Network (PCN) as well as targeted support for people in Surrey's top 5 key neighbourhoods and other priority populations, contributing to Surrey County Councils' ambition that no one is left behind.

The programme will run from October 2023 to March 2025 and aims to support 2882 people to access and maintain work. The programme will be delivered in partnership with Surrey Heartlands and Frimley ICSs and will be open to residents from 16 years +.
