10	HIGH STREET, BAGSHOT - REMOVAL OF PARKING BAYS	The Local Committee approved the proposal for the removal of the four parking places outside Anchor House, High Street, Bagshot and their replacement with double yellow lines. The Local Committee agreed that the County Council make an Order under the relevant parts of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for this amendment, that it is advertised and that if no objections are maintained, the Order is made. The Local Committee agreed that the Parking Strategy and Implementation Team Manager will consider and resolve objections and that should any objections not be readily resolvable, that these objections will be determined by the Parking Strategy and Implementation Team Manager in consultation with the Chairman, Vice Chairman and the relevant County Councillor.
11	BAGSHOT ROAD, CHOBHAM - ALTERATION TO PARKING RESTRICTION	The Local Committee approved the proposal for the reduction of the single yellow line outside 2 Bagshot Road, Chobham, where the entrance of the new development starts. The Local Committee agreed the intention of the County Council to make an Order under the relevant parts of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and for this amendment to be advertised and that, if no objections are maintained, the Order is made;

The Local Committee agreed that the Parking Strategy and Implementation Team Manager will consider and try to resolve any objections and that a decision on any remaining unresolved objections will be made by the Parking Strategy and Implementation Team Manager in consultation with the Chairman, Vice Chairman and the relevant County Councillor.
