		<p>i) Neither a 20mph limit or zone be introduced in White Rose Lane;</p> <p>ii) The traffic calmed length of White Rose Lane is resurfaced, including the reconstruction of the speed cushions, when funds are available.</p> <p>iii) A follow up report be brought back to the Joint Committee in 12 months following the introduction of the revised Speed Limit Policy. This report should be a holistic consideration of White Rose Lane, East Hill, Park Road and Maybury Hill.</p> <p><u>Reason for recommendation:</u></p> <p>The length of road that already has traffic calming features would benefit from being resurfaced and the existing speed cushions rebuilt as soon as funds allow.</p>
