		<p><u>Reason for decisions</u></p> <p>The above decisions were made because although the provision of a continuous route for pedestrians and cyclists between Chobham and Woking would be ideal, the financial and physical constraints do not currently make this route possible.</p>
<p>8</p>	<p>PARKING ENFORCEMENT REPORT</p>	<p>The Woking Joint Committee agreed that the parking surplus of £87,553 is distributed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) £20,000 to continue to fund an apprentice to assist with ongoing Parking Reviews across the Woking Borough; b) £67,553 to supplement the Highways budget for 2018 / 2019. <p><u>Reason for the decisions</u></p> <p>The above decisions were made in order to assist with enforcement of waiting and parking restrictions resulting in improved road safety, assisting in access of emergency services, improving traffic flow and maintaining access to shops.</p>
