<b>5b</b>	PETITION TO: INTRODUCE A 20MPH SPEED LIMIT ON ALL RESIDENTIAL STREETS IN ASHTEAD WITH THE EXCLUSION OF THE A24	The Local Committee noted:  1) That the petition to introduce a 20mph speed limit on all of the requested roads in Ashtead and response.  2) To continue to support the introduction of self-enforcing 20mph speed limits outside schools in Ashtead.  The Local Committee agreed:  i) That officers <del>could</del> <b>should</b> work with the divisional member, <b>the petitioner</b> and Ashtead
