That the proposed Fair Access Protocol for 2021/22 was approved.

- The local authority is required to have a Fair Access Protocol in place that all schools must participate in.
- The proposed Protocol meet the requirements of the new School Admissions Code, which came into effect on 1 September 2021.
- The Protocol will ensure that vulnerable and unplaced children can be placed in school quickly where they are unable to secure a place through the normal in-year admissions procedure.
- When seeking to place a child under the Protocol, no school will be asked to take a
 disproportionate number of children who have been permanently excluded from other
 schools, who display challenging behaviour, or who meet one of the other categories
 set out in the protocol.
- It is proposed to consult schools more fully on the practical operation of the Protocol
 in the autumn term once term is underway and schools become familiar with the
 requirements of the new School Admissions Code.
