1	By 19 December 2013	Draft report submitted to Principal Highways Solicitor.
2	13 January 2014	Confirm inclusion of report with Reigate and Banstead Local Committee for agenda planning
3	20 January 2014	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• County Council notifies interested parties of date of committee and deadlines.</li> <li>• Leaflet entitled "speaking at committee" circulated and report summary.</li> <li>• Invited to submit final representations <u>4</u> weeks before committee.</li> </ul>
4	31 January 2014	Draft reports to Local Committee manager
5	7 February 2014	Last day for receipt of submissions for inclusion in report.
6	12 February 2014	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Submission of final report to committee.</li> <li>• List produced of those eligible to speak.</li> <li>• Final report to interested parties</li> </ul>
7	3 March 2014 (2pm)	Reigate and Banstead Local Committee (Reigate Town Hall)
8	10 March 2014 (or when draft minutes are received)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inform all interested parties of committee decision</li> <li>• Inform applicant of decision.</li> <li>• <u>If no order</u> to be made the applicant has 28 days to appeal to the Secretary of State against the decision.</li> </ul>
If order to be made:		
9	By end March 2014 (e.g. Thurs 27 March 2013)	Legal Order made and advertised (if committee decide to make order)
10	12 May 2013	End of objection period to order (6 weeks + weekend)
If no objections are received to the order		
11	By end of May (e.g. 29 May 2014)	Order is confirmed and advertised (6 weeks + weekend).
12	10 July 2014	End of confirmation period during which anyone can appeal to the High Court.
<b><i>At end of this period route added to Definitive Map and Statement</i></b>		
If objections are received to order.		
13	Autumn/ winter 2014	Submission assembled with all relevant evidence and submitted to the Secretary of State.
14	6-8 Months after receipt by SoS	Order determined by Public Inquiry/Hearing/Written Representations.
15	See part 11-12	If the Inspector confirms the order then it will be advertised as such.
