Dear Resident or Business Owner,

High Street, Bookham – Proposed Improvements

Surrey County Council Highways Officers have been working with Bookham Residents' Association and County Councillor Clare Curran to develop proposals to improve the High Street, in particular works to improve traffic flow and the pedestrian environment.

Double yellow lines have recently been installed following the Mole Valley Parking Review 2013-14. These aim to create passing places for traffic to ease congestion. An initial design has been undertaken to build upon these parking restrictions. I am writing to share this with you and to seek your views. The proposals include:

- Additional double yellow lines to create passing places for traffic to ease congestion
- Provision of pedestrian crossing points on raised tables

The proposals are shown on the enclosed drawing. A larger copy of the drawing is available for viewing at Bookham Library (Townshott Close, KT23 4DQ).


As part of the detailed design, we will also be investigating possibilities to increase pavement width, whilst retaining an acceptable carriageway width for traffic. Funding will be from the budget for improvement schemes, as agreed by Mole Valley Local Committee. There is also some funding set aside to benefit the local community from contributions received from developments in the area.

It is important that the views of the residents and business owners form part of the process of developing a scheme that is supported by the local community. Therefore I would be grateful if you could spare the time to complete and return the short questionnaire in the postage paid envelope provided by **Monday 18 August 2014**.

The results of the consultation will be analysed and a report, including recommendations, will be submitted to Mole Valley Local Committee for decision.
