Why will it have taken over a year to get a Village Gateway sign erected by Highways when the parish council are paying for it? Please can Highways formally reply to the query about the progress of the gate?****Reply from John Hilder, SCC**

We have many highway schemes being designed across the borough and it can take some time for them to be completed, I apologise for the delay.

3. Question from Marushka Broughton, Parent, Aldershot Road Crossing**Please can you confirm that the crossing patrol at St Josephs School is a temporary measure and the scheme to upgrade the pedestrian crossing will be considered in the future? Why isn't Highways paying for the patrol?****Reply from the Chairman**

Rebecca Harrison, SCC came along and gave training to parents on running a crossing patrol. The scheme is very much on the Highway Scheme list and will be considered in the future.

4. Question from Doug Clare Guildford Bike User group (GBUG)**Doug thanked Marc Woohall and his team for consulting with GBUG.**

Q1. Will Annex B in the Cycling report be included in the Highways Forward Programme for 2016/17 Budget?

Q2. Can the connection of the Shalford cycle path to the High Street Bridge be prioritised and please can Marc Woohall continue to consult with G BUG?

5. Question from Julie Brown, Newlands Corner Campaign Group

Please can you ensure that a 2 or 3 hour parking limitation is put in place in Merrow Road near the shops?
