Getting to Clare and Anderson wards from the Elmbridge area

The wards are located in the Abraham Cowley Unit, St Peter's Hospital, Holloway Hill, Chertsey, KT16 0AE.

St Peter's Hospital is located between Woking and Chertsey close to junction 11 of the M25.



By car

There are three ways to get to junction 11 of the M25, depending where in Elmbridge you live:

Via the A3, which joins the M25 at Junction 10

- Follow the M25 north (Heathrow) for one junction and exit at junction 11
- At the top of the slip road, take the left hand exit onto the A317,
 St Peter's Way
- You will approach a roundabout where there are signs for St Peter's Hospital.
 Take the right hand exit onto the A320, Guildford Road
- At the next roundabout, take the second exit to enter the hospital site.

Via the A317 (High Street/Weybridge Road/Woburn Hill, St Peter's Way) in Weybridge

- As you approach Junction 11, go straight over the roundabout on St Peter's Way
- You will approach a roundabout where there are signs for St Peter's Hospital. Take the right hand exit onto the A320, Guildford Road
- At the next roundabout, take the second exit to enter the hospital site.

Via the A308 (Hampton Court Road/Upper Sunbury Road) and M3, which joins the M25 at junction 12

- Follow the M25 south (Gatwick) for one junction and exit at junction 11
- At the top of the slip road, take the right hand exit onto the A317,
 St Peter's Way
- You will approach a roundabout where there are signs for St Peter's Hospital. Take the right hand exit onto the A320, Guildford Road
- At the next roundabout, take the second exit to enter the hospital site.

Finding the Abraham Cowley Unit

The Abraham Cowley Unit is at the top of the St Peter's Hospital site.

As you enter the site, go right at the mini roundabout and follow the road round to the right (uphill). The Abraham Cowley Unit is signposted.
