- The data above is provided by Surrey Police and presented to the Surrey Crisis Care Concordat Delivery Group. This shows people defined as MISPER 'Missing People' who are assessed to need police support to locate people missing from the wards. This is a wider definition than AWOLS (people absent from the ward who are detained under the Mental Health Act).
- It shows the figures of MISPER per beds - as sites are of different sizes. The Trust average per bed = 1.19 and at Langley Wing (Epsom) =1.71 (45% higher). Langley Wing (Epsom) has had highest rate of MISPER for 2/3 quarters (to date).
- The new procedure of escorting people into the servery at Langley Wing (Epsom) has led to a clear reduction of MISPER reports (in Q2 & Q3) – but at the expense of patient experience.
- Note the following:
 - Figures above are MISPER across site but the calculations are against 'Adult' beds only – if the figures were calculated to also include Older Adult Beds (at ACU and FRH) rates would change (0.65 at ACU and 0.85 FRH), the rates at Langley Wing (Epsom) would be unchanged.

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
