Thank you for advising us of this application. Schedule 2, paragraph 19(5) of the NHS (Pharmaceutical and Local Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations 2013 (as amended) requires the Health and Wellbeing Board to make representations on consolidation applications to NHS England. This letter therefore fulfils this requirement and sets out the Surrey Health and Wellbeing Board view.

Following a review of the Surrey Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) published in March 2018, having requested representations from Healthwatch and the Clinical Commissioning Group and after consultation with Surrey HWBB members, the view of the board is that the application would not create a gap in pharmaceutical services provision.

The application informs us that after consolidation:


- Proposed core opening hours will not change. Proposed total opening hours will increase;
