The Committee agreed Highways would discuss with the divisional Member and if appropriate when costings established write a letter to Tesco to ask if they could contribute. SCC could also ask the Parish and District Councils to do the same to strengthen the request.</p>	Open	Area Highway Manager	<p>Section 106 funding was collected from the Oak Grove (Oaklands Hospital) site to provide improvements to pedestrian crossing facilities in the vicinity of the development. A meeting was held with the divisional Member at the time Cllr Orrick to look at a number of locations where improvements to pedestrian crossing facilities have been requested. Following this meeting the provision of a pedestrian crossing facility in Banstead Road has been designed and the divisional Member (Cllr Botten) and District Councillor (Cllr Rujbally) consulted on the proposed crossing. S106 funding for construction of the crossing has been transferred to SCC from TDC.</p> <p>Detailed design work on this scheme is complete and consultation is currently being carried out.</p>
