#### **Question 1: Mr Richard Banks**

I am a resident of Lee Street which in recent years has developed in to a rat run. The road runs between A217 and A23 and gives access to Horley Leisure Centre. The road is so busy it is impossible to cross during rush hour. Vehicles are using excessive speed and minor accidents are a frequent and weekly occurrence. The road safety and noise pollution along this road are of big concern to the residents and therefore I'd like to request if traffic calming measures could be installed.
