This report seeks the appointment of a Surrey County Council Member to the 40 Degreez Centre for Young People, Farnham, as the Local Committee representative, during the current municipal year.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Waverley Local Committee is asked to agree that:

- (i) One Surrey County Council Member be appointed to the 40 Degreez Centre for Young People, Farnham, as detailed in the report, section 2.2.
- (ii) The Member be allowed to bring update reports from the 40 Degreez Centre, when relevant.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

The purpose of this report is to enable the Waverley Local Committee to be represented at the 40 Degreez Centre for Young People in Farnham and for the nominated member to be able to report back to the Local Committee when relevant.

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND:

- 1.1 The Local Committee can appoint Members to various outside bodies, partnerships and boards. To enable Members to report progress on the activities in which they are involved on behalf of the Local Committee, update reports should be made available when relevant.

- 2.1 The Local Committee membership of outside bodies, partnerships and boards will be reviewed and agreed by the Local Committee annually. The Committee is asked to make the appointment as listed in section 2.2.

2.2 40 DEGREEZ CENTRE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE, FARNHAM

The 40 Degreez Centre provides a venue for all young people in the Farnham area (currently around 5,000 in the age range 10 to 25 years old) to meet in a safe and informal environment, supporting a variety of leisure, social and advisory activities.

40 Degreez values input from a Surrey County Council representative. In the past it has allowed the organisation to view the bigger picture regarding youth provision in the county and has proven useful for the SCC representative to gain knowledge of activities and services offered at 40 Degreez. 40 Degreez believes that this two way information channel has been productive and meaningful and hopes it will continue in the future.

The nominated SCC Member should have specific local knowledge of Farnham. It would also be helpful if the Member has skills and knowledge in networking, management, interest in young people and their issues, medical knowledge (mental health) and accountancy.

Meetings take place during the day at the 40 Degreez Centre, Dogflud Way, Farnham GU9 7UD. The SCC nominated Member would be expected to attend meetings quarterly.

It is proposed that Mr Andy MacLeod (County Councillor) be appointed to the 40 Degreez Centre for Young People, Farnham.

3.1 The option is to appoint a representative to 40 Degreez, or to not appoint.
