St Barnabas DofE Group	DofE Expedition Costs and Provision of Computer and Printer	4000	All funds have been spent on IT equipment and 3 expeditions. Some equipment bought will be used for future expeditions. Two expeditions were for the DofE Gold Award, with young people camping and trekking for 4 days in Wales.  Organisation says – '14 young people successfully completed their Gold practice and their Gold final expeditions and this has been enabled by Surrey small youth grant When you talk to the young people of their experiences they are very proud of themselves and they say that they feel more confident, resilient and empowered as a result of their accomplishment'
Walton-on-Thames Cricket Club	Training of Volunteeer Coaches for Junior Cricket Section	1650	All funds spent to help fund the cost of training 12 volunteer coaches to achieve ECB Level 1 status.  Organisations says – 'We have already started to see an impact. Training sessions have just started for the junior section. So far, we have about 165 boys and girls registered from 7-17 years and the coaches are running sessions on Sunday mornings and Friday evenings.'

CODS Youth Action Group	Cookery & Catering Course	2000	Grant used for hall hire, food and equipment for cookery course. Some funds remain which will be used for courses in 2013.  Organisation says – 'This was a new activity for CODS Youth Action Group youth, aged between 11 and 18, the majority from local housing trust homes in Cobham. During 2012 and 2013 our volunteers have been able to give around 25 young people the opportunity to learn to cook. We were pleased to see both boys and girls attended the sessions. Some had never cooked before and some were a little more experienced.  Nevertheless all of them participated well and produced many tasty dishes. The youth were also taught some health and safety rules, and how to use some of the kitchen equipment, serving, presentation and catering to some invited guests e.g. the local neighbourhood police team.'
