The Committee agreed a new recommendation suggested by the Leader of TDC to reduce the lorries to 112 movements a day rather than 156.</p> <p>The quarry operator has appealed the decision and the restrictions on movements cannot be imposed until the appeal is heard in January 2020.</p> <p>Subject to Committee approval the physical width restriction will be designed and constructed over the next two financial years.</p>

The amendments to the traffic orders have been finalised, which means that once the lines and/or signs are put in place, the new restrictions will come into effect. Although it does depend partly on the weather, as it is not possible to paint yellow lines on wet roads, we are hoping that this will all be completed before the end of the year.
