PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2012

This Order is made by Surrey County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the landowner it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted. _____

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Surrey County Council definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement. _____

Mr and Mrs Cronk of Harts Lane Cottage, Harts Lane, Godstone have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public. _____

Tandridge District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act. _____

BY THIS ORDER:-

1 THE public right of way over the land situated to the west and north of Harts Lane Cottage and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall at the date of certification of this Order be stopped up and thereupon the Surrey County Council definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way. _____

2 THERE shall at the date of certification of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated to the east of Harts Lane Cottage described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Surrey County Council definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.

3. THE Surrey County Council Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this order. _____

Description of site of existing path or way

Footpath 140B (Godstone) from point 'A' in a northerly direction to point 'B', then in a north easterly direction to points 'C', 'D' and 'E' being a total distance of 293m, as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/26/H32. _____

Part 2

Description of site of new path or way

Footpath 140B (Godstone) from point 'G' in a north westerly direction through point 'F' to point 'E' being a total distance of 234m, as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/26/H32. The path to have a width of 2m. There are kissing gates at G and F with a width of 1.4m _____

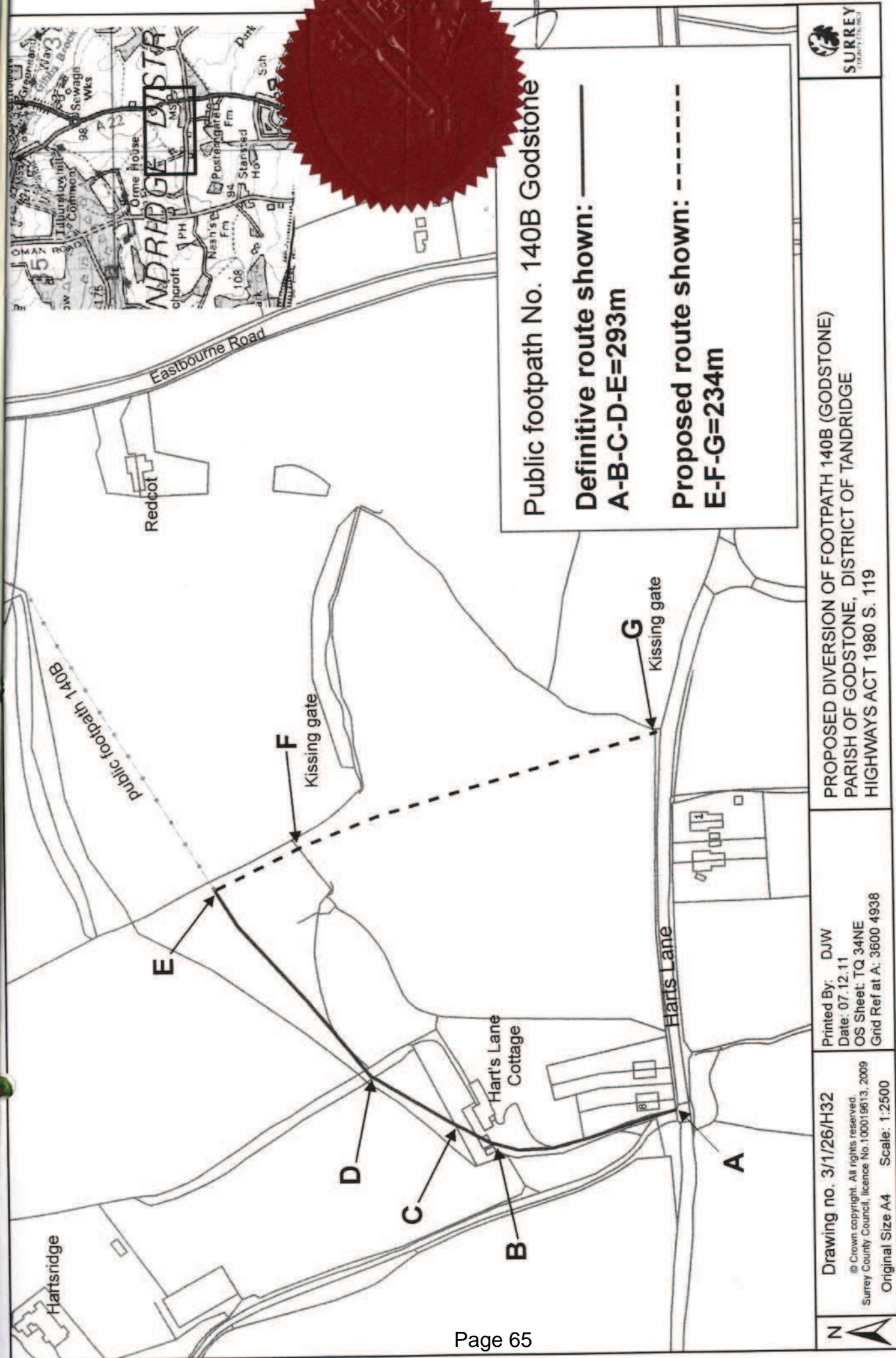
