Spelthorne Joint Committee: Request for Stanwell Quarry site visit.

I write to you as the Chairman of Spelthorne Joint Committee in relation to your site in Stanwell Place that is earmarked for development as part of the Heathrow expansion project and in so doing, offer you an opportunity to raise the profile of your project and foster goodwill in the local community.

Spelthorne Joint Committee is a decision making body made up of local councillors from both the county and borough councils and exists to improve and influence the outcome of issues that affect the borough of Spelthorne's residents. The proximity of Heathrow to Stanwell means that any matters pertaining to the airport are of particular interest to our residents. The development and restoration of the site at Stanwell Quarry is a subject that has drawn particular attention and has been brought before the committee on a number of occasions.

As the proposals for the expansion of Heathrow progress, it is recognised that your own vision for the site would have evolved alongside it and away from the original plan that was submitted for approval by Surrey County Council. I would therefore welcome a chance to meet with you on site, alongside my vice-chairman, the divisional member for Stanwell and key officers to gain an understanding of the conceptual plan and how it meets the requirements within the geographical boundaries.



This meeting would be in the best interests of both parties providing an opportunity for mutual understanding and the potential for positive publicity for both organisations.

In addition to the above, I would also like to offer an open invitation to address the Joint Committee at a future meeting. The committee currently meets quarterly to address local issues and to provide a vehicle for public engagement whereby local residents can register their concerns.
