#### WRITTEN MEMBERS' QUESTIONS

Question 1: Sinead Mooney, Surrey County Council Divisional Member for Staines.

**I note the feasibility study for Gresham Road traffic calming measures is underway. The study is to include surrounding roads. Can this please be expanded to include Laleham Road up to the junction with Carlyle Road.**

Officer response:

The Area Highways Manager has advised that Laleham Road should be investigated as part of a feasibility scheme, in its own right.

Question 2 : Sinead Mooney, Surrey County Council Divisional Member for Staines

**Staines High Street is fully accessible since the failure of previous safety mechanisms to prevent unmanaged vehicular access. Over the years there has been several discussions about the safety of Staines High Street, with particular reference being made to the potential threat of a terrorist attack. The general view is shoppers, businesses and the general public could be at significant risk and that the establishment of a sustainable access control feature is required. Can consideration be given to this as a priority?**

Officer response:

In light of the risk that is posed by a potential terrorist incident, it has been decided in consultation with committee members and the business community to incorporate a feasibility study into this year's programme. Please see the published decisions document (item 9)
