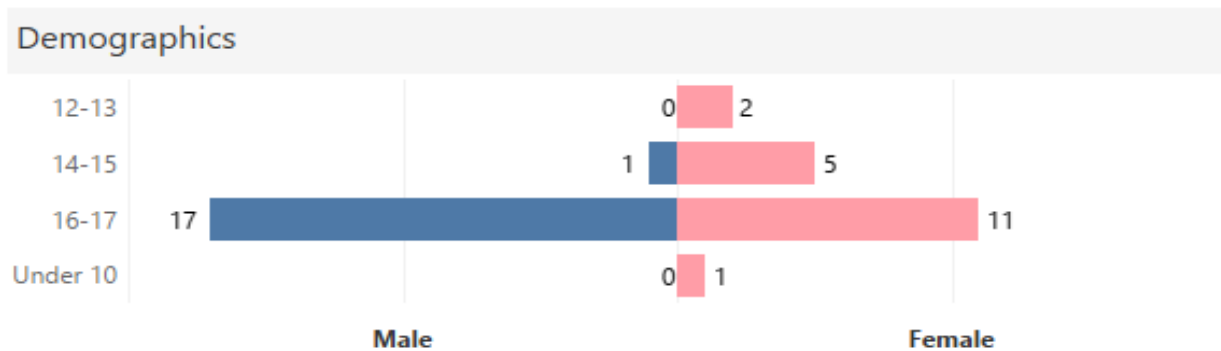


Looked After Children at Risk of Exploitation

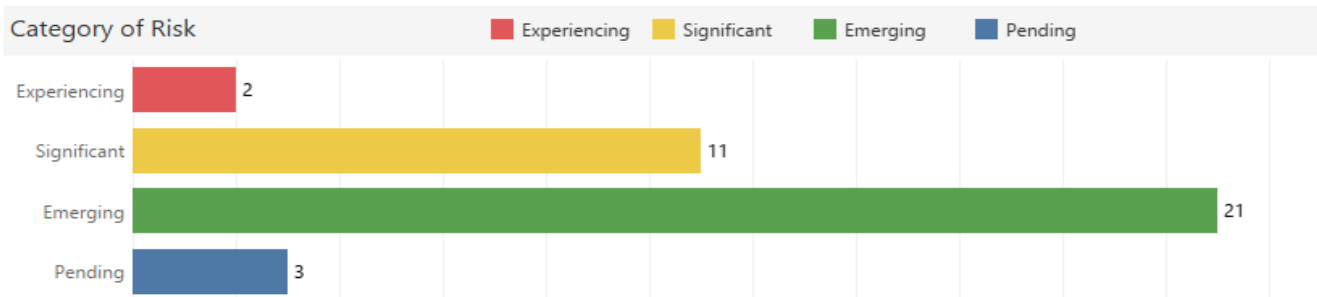
Following recent research Surrey has now implemented a more specific Red, Amber Green (RAG) rating:

- Red = Experiencing
- Amber = Significant
- Green = Emerging

Of the 166 children currently identified as at risk of exploitation, 37 children (22%) are currently looked after.



The age/gender profile above shows the breakdown of current looked after children who are identified as at risk of exploitation. Males aged 16-17 years old account for 46% of those identified as at risk.



There are 2 looked after children who have been identified as experiencing exploitation.

Of the 37 looked after children identified as at risk of exploitation, 17 (46%) have had a previous exploitation episode recorded at any point in the past. There were 11 children (30%) where the current episode had started within 12 months of the previous one ending.

These figures are based on information as recorded on the Liquidlogic children's system (LCS) and therefore may differ to information available in the service.
