#### CONCERNS OVER THE NEW RELOCATED BARRIER LYNE ROAD

Along with all the other reasons I quoted in January 2012, one major problem has come to light. With the removal of the barrier on the east part of Lyne Road, we are experiencing complete road blockage caused by larger vehicles tipping debris in the centre of the road which can remain for many days. As fire engines and emergency vehicles can only enter Lyne Road from the "Paddocks" end and in the event of the road being impassable, every property in Lyne Road would be without cover for these services.

I suggest removal of the barrier to the right on entering Lyne Road and securing a suitable notice on the remaining barrier such as "Only authorised HGV's beyond this point" allowing a fire engine entry from either end and making it clear to other HGV drivers that the road in unsuitable for their vehicle. This would give us peace of mind that we and our properties are safe.

If you agree with the above, please sign this petition. However should you have other views on the matter, I would appreciate your input.

I propose passing this petition to our councillor, Mel Few, so that the matter can be considered at a Council meeting in July, or even set the ball rolling before that date, as I am sure you will agree it is extremely important.
