Match funding Consideration of the proportional contribution of CIL to total project costs and the extent to which CIL funding would enable additional funding to be secured No funding from other sources – 0 1-20% funding from other sources – 1 21-40% funding from other sources – 2 41-60% funding from other sources – 3 61-80% funding from other sources – 4 81% + funding from other sources - 5	20%
Value for money Consideration of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CIL sought in relation to benefits to the local area - Suitability to be considered for CIL funding - Alternative funding sources available and considered 	20%
Deliverability Assessment of feasibility of scheme: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stage of project development - Status of funding - Long term sustainability of project 	10%
