SUBJECT: HIGHWAY SCHEMES UPDATE

DIVISION: ALL REIGATE AND BANSTEAD DIVISIONS



#### **SUMMARY OF ISSUE:**

At the 4 March 2013 Local Committee, Members agreed a programme of revenue and capital highway works in Reigate and Banstead. Delegated Authority was given to enable the forward programme to be progressed without the need to bring further reports to the Local Committee for decision. This report sets out recent progress.

The estimated cost of implementing the ITS scheme for a pedestrian refuge in Croydon Lane, Banstead is over double the funding allocated by Local Committee for implementation due to the need to divert utility company equipment. This report seeks approval not to progress this at the current time

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

#### The Local Committee (Reigate & Banstead) is asked to:

- (i) Note the contents of Annex 1; and
- (ii) Agree that the proposal to provide a pedestrian refuge in Croydon Lane, Banstead is not progressed at the current time.

#### **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:**

To update the Local Committee on the progress of the highway works programme in Reigate and Banstead and to defer the scheme for Croydon Lane, Banstead.

## 1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND:

- 1.1 In March 2013, Local Committee agreed its forward programme for both Integrated Transport Schemes (ITS) Capital Improvement Schemes and ITS Capital Maintenance Schemes. Local Committee also agreed the allocation of its revenue budget for maintenance works.
- 1.2 To allow flexibility in the delivery of the Local Committee's highways work programme, delegated authority was given so that works could be

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progressed without the need to bring further reports to the Local Committee for decision. Where it is agreed that a scheme should not proceed for any reason, a report should be submitted to the next formal meeting of the Local Committee for resolution.

1.3 In addition to the Local Committee's devolved highways budget, developer contributions are used to fund, either wholly or in part, highway improvement schemes to mitigate the impact of developments on the highway network.

## 2. ANALYSIS:

- 2.1 Annex 1 sets out progress on the approved programme of highway works in Reigate and Banstead. It also provides an update on schemes being progressed using developer contributions.
- 2.2 **Croydon Lane, Banstead:** Bus route 166 was rerouted from Woodmansterne Lane to the A2022 Croydon Lane a number of years ago. Residents reported difficulties crossing Croydon Lane and requested a pedestrian crossing facility by provided. Transport for London was approached in 2008 for funding but, like the rest of the public sector, were operating under tight budget constraints which meant that they could not fund the scheme. Local Committee allocated funding in 2011/12, which was carried forward to 2012/13, for design work. £30,050 was allocated this financial year for construction. However, the road width is insufficient to provide a pedestrian refuge without localised widening and there is BT plant in the verge which will require diversion. Current estimates for plant diversion and construction are £33,730 and £36,100 respectively.
- 2.3 Under the delegated powers referred to in para 1.2 of this report, the Local Committee Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Area Team Manager agreed that due to insufficient funding, the scheme would not be progressed at the current time. Subject to Local Committee agreeing that the scheme should not proceed, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Area Team Manager have agreed under delegated powers that the balance of the funding allocated to the Croydon Lane scheme be vired to the Woodhatch Road, Redhill safety scheme, which, due to the length of anti-skid being provided, is currently over-budget.

5.1Budgets are closely monitored throughout the financial year and monthly updates are provided to the Local Committee Chairman and Vice-Chairman. The Local Committee have put in place arrangements whereby monies can be vired between different schemes and budget headings.

6.1 It is an objective of Surrey Highways to treat all users of the public highway equally and with understanding. The needs of all road users are considered as part of the design process for highway schemes.

#### 7. LOCALISM:

7.1 Funding has been allocated from the revenue maintenance budget to fund the Highways Localism Initiative.
