Note: this development is now being marketed by the developer as 'Abbey View'.</p>	OPEN – to be closed once works completed	Highways – Transport Development Planning Officer / Maintenance Engineer (Road Safety and Active Travel Team responded to the petition)	<p>The S106 money from the Hopfields developments has now been paid to the county council.</p> <p>The detailed design for the works is underway and it is anticipated that works will commence towards the end of 2021.</p>
2	22 March 2019	<p><b>PETITION RESPONSE</b></p> <p>PETITION FOR 7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION, STATION LANE, SALT LANE AND MARKWICK LANE.</p>	OPEN	Area Highway Manager (SW)	<p>The Local Committee decided on 19 June 2020 that this should be added to the Decision Tracker to monitor HGVs on rural roads between Cranleigh and the A3, including Markwick Lane.</p> <p>A verbal update was provided at the 26 March 2021 Local Committee. The survey report has now been circulated to Members, for their consideration.</p>

Residents report the green filter arrow for traffic turning right into Wharf Street.	OPEN	Area Highway Manager	<p>It was requested that the Area Highway Manager check these issues with the Traffic Signals team.</p> <p>The road safety working group is now due to look at the junction shortly.</p>

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
