Item 6 - REVISIONS to Appendix 1

The following revisions should be noted in Appendix 1 (Powerpoint Presentation exported to PDF) of the Health and Well-Being Strategy Index Scorecard (Item 6) published on Tuesday 11 June 2024 (Appendix 1 is revised and attached):

Typographical Errors

Slide 18 (Page 20)

Emergency hospital admission rates of people with dementia – figures on this line are numbers, not percentages as stated.

This is the rate of people admitted to hospital emergency departments for any reason who have dementia per 1,000 of the population (i.e. Surrey figure is 5.2 people with dementia out of 1,000).

Slide 24 (Page 26)

Proportion of households owed a homelessness duty – figures on this line are numbers, not percentages as stated.

This is the rate (not proportion) of households in an area assessed as being owed a homelessness duty* (from a local authority/borough and districts) per 1,000 households (i.e. Surrey figure is 7 households out of 1,000).

* Prevention duty: Local authorities owe prevention duties to help stop households at risk of homelessness losing their accommodation. Relief duty: If a household is homeless, the local authority owes them a relief duty to provide some sort of accommodation.

Further clarification

Slide 27 (Page 29)

Rate of young people aged 16–18 participating in training, education or employment.

This is the percentage of the 16-18 year old population who are known to be in employment, training or education. This is a proportion, not a rate as stated (Surrey figure is 75.4%).
