TITLE: Anti-skid surfacing for Succombs Hill

We the undersigned petition Surrey County Council to Install an anti-skid surface to the top bends of Succombs Hill, Warlingham.

Justification:

There have been multiple incidents in the last few months, often of fairly significant severity due to the lack of surface grip at the top of Succombs hill. This has resulted on a number of occasions vehicles almost leaving the road completely.

RESPONSE:

We have analysed the accident records for this location and they do not point to an issue with skid resistance therefore it is not considered appropriate to lay High Friction Surfacing in this location. This treatment is not sustainable in terms of cost; durability and environmental footprint so should only be use where necessary.

We will conduct a visual assessment later this year and note any potential to improve signage or road layout etc. However, it remains the responsibility of users to drive in accordance with the road conditions.
