Paper 1: Improving Healthcare Together 2020 to 2030 – Programme update

5th June 2020

1. Introduction

Following the consultation closure on the 1st of April 2020, Opinion Research Services (ORS) have undertaken their independent consultation analysis of all consultation feedback on the proposals to address the challenges facing Epsom and St Helier University Hospitals NHS Trust. ORS will present their consultation report to Members at the Adults and Health Select Committee on the 5th of June. The report and accompanying presentation (which should be read in conjunction with the full analysis report) is included in **Papers 2.a** and respectively **Paper 2.b**.

This report will be used as one of the pieces of evidence, alongside other evidence to inform NHS South West London and NHS Surrey Heartlands Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) decision making process.

Members are asked to note that this consultation has been monitored by the Consultation Institute, under its Consultation Quality Assurance Scheme. The Institute is happy to confirm that this consultation has fully met the requirements for best practice.

2. Additional evidence to support the CCGs decision making process

There are a number of pieces of additional evidence that the CCGs will use to inform their decision-making process which will include, but are not limited to the South West London and Surrey Joint Health and Overview Scrutiny IHT Committee (JHOSC) consultation response.

The CCGs have noted confirmation from Councillor Stears on the 29th of April that the IHT JHOSC will provide its formal response to the Improving Healthcare Together 2020 to 2030 proposals under regulation 23 of the Local Authority (Public Health, Health and Wellbeing Boards and Health Scrutiny) Regulations 2013, by the 19th of June 2020.

3. Next steps

No decisions have been made. Following deliberation of all the evidence by the CCGs, the proposed date by which the CCGs will make a final decision on its proposals on the 3rd of July 2020 at the CCGs Committees in Common as confirmed in correspondence on the 1st of May 2020 between Sarah Blow and Matthew Tait to Councillor Stears.
