

Approx 30m of double yellow line to protect proposed crossing from parked vehicles. Double yellow lines to extend to tangent point of Berryscroft Road (East)

Approx 3no. on street parking space removed (shown purple).


New 2m wide dropped kerbs.

Approx 30m of double yellow line to provide improved visibility to the west for pedestrians crossing. It would also serve to cover the existing driveways of numbers 48 and 50.
