
Appendix B - High-level Roadmap and milestones for 23/24

foundations	Master Data – Achievement of 4 groups of master data records	Q3	Master data records to be in place for – Children with SEND, Vulnerable Residents during an emergency, Property, Employees.
	Data Quality tool – Aperture – use case review point (c7 use cases completed)	Q3	The roll out of Aperture via use cases will be ongoing. This milestone (c7 use cases) will review progress to date and support further planning for 24/25.
	Complete Data architecture review	Q3	Review data architecture (including databases, applications, integration, security, workflows, information architecture design and associated data processes) to identify gaps and opportunities to develop our capabilities.

Increasing engagement & skills	Establish SCC Data Academy	Q1	The Academy will have distinct programmes for leaders, officers (focussed on data management, using insight tools, basic data analysis skills and data literacy), and analysts (focussed on storytelling and impact measurement).
	Data Asks & Skills Audits launched across organisation	Q3	The Data Asks and Skills Audits will be tested within the organisation in early 2023 and further refined/built for launch in Q3.
