Clarification on Calculating protected Final Pay

Following a query on how to calculate protected Final Pay, the LGA have provided an example on pages 4 & 5 of Bulletin 229.

Letter about discrimination in the LGPS sent to minister

On 26 August 2022, Cllr Roger Phillips, Chair of the SAB, wrote to the Local Government Minister, Paul Scully. The letter to the minister recommends amending the regulations on death grants and survivor benefits.

The SAB expressed concern about continuing to restrict death grants to cases where the member died before age 75. It considers the restriction may be at risk of legal challenge and should be removed.

The SAB reminded the minister that the LGPS rules on survivor benefits have not yet been amended to reflect the Goodwin judgment. It has previously recommended the Government investigate the feasibility of removing all differences in the survivor benefit rules.

HMRC Newsletter

On 31 August 2022, HMRC published <u>pension schemes newsletter 142</u>. The newsletter includes articles:

- normal minimum pension age updates to the pensions tax manual
- migrating your pension schemes take action now
- Accounting for Tax returns can no longer be completed for any quarter from 1 April 2020 using the pension schemes online service
- new scams strategy from The Pensions Regulator see bulletin 228 for more information.

Firstly, a reminder to complete your Responsible Investment Consultation survey before it closes on 6 November.

We're happy to announce that we have had over 5,600 responses to the survey so far!

Once the survey closes we will be analysing the responses and comments from members and the general public. The findings of the consultation will then be discussed by the Surrey Pension Committee in January with the results of the survey also being published on the Surrey Pension Fund website.



Button V - Future Payroll Numbers Set to Start at S1500001

I picked up that the manually assigned Payroll Numbers on "Retirements and Dependants #Special-V1" were getting very near to <u>S1010000</u>. Given the automated Altair numbering starts at <u>1010000</u> I wanted to try and avoid confusion with very similar payroll numbers (for example when a member contacts us, or an immediate payment is being processed).


To help avoid any mix-ups I have made a jump in the numbering on the Excel sheet "Retirements and Dependents #Special-V1", with payroll numbers in future starting at <u>S1500001</u>.

The Excel sheet works just the same as before, and the only difference is the jump in the payroll numbering. For clarity, any payroll numbers already assigned <u>do not</u> need to be updated as part of this change.

While updating this I saw there several old tabs on the Excel sheet that took a long time to load and save and are no longer used so I have archived these. I have also archived payroll numbers set up before July 2022.

Me in particular!


